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# 7 U.S. Code § 1638

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## Definitions

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In this subchapter:

**(1) Covered commodity**

**(A) In general**

The term “covered commodity” means—

- (i) muscle cuts of lamb and venison;
- (ii) ground lamb and ground venison;
- (iii) farm-raised fish;
- (iv) wild fish;
- (v) a perishable agricultural commodity;
- (vi) peanuts; and <sup>11</sup>
- (vii) meat produced from goats;
- (viii) chicken, in whole and in part;
- (ix) ginseng;
- (x) pecans; and
- (xi) macadamia nuts.

**(B) Exclusions**

The term “covered commodity” does not include an item described in subparagraph (A) if the item is an ingredient in a processed food item.

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
