

7 U.S. Code § 1638

Definitions

In this subchapter:

(1) Covered commodity

(A) In general

The term "covered commodity" means—

- (i) muscle cuts of lamb and venison;
- (ii) ground lamb and ground venison;
- (iii) farm-raised fish;
- (iv) wild fish;
- (v) a perishable agricultural commodity;
- (vi) peanuts; and [1]
- (vii) meat produced from goats;
- (viii) chicken, in whole and in part;
- (ix) ginseng;
- (x) pecans; and
- (xi) macadamia nuts.

(B) Exclusions

The term "covered commodity" does not include an item described in subparagraph (A) if the item is an ingredient in a processed food item.
