### PM10 State implementation plan development in group II areas.

---

The state of Nebraska committed to conform to the PM<sub>10</sub> regulations as set forth in 40 CFR part 51. In a letter to Morris Kay, EPA, dated February 5, 1988, Mr. Dennis Grams, Director, Nebraska Department of Environmental Control, stated:

- (a) An area in the City of Omaha and the area in and around the Village of Weeping Water have been classified as Group II areas for the purpose of PM<sub>10</sub> State Implementation Plan (SIP) development. The specific boundaries of these areas are identified in our letter of October 6, 1987, to Carl Walter. In accordance with the requirements for PM<sub>10</sub> SIP development, the State of Nebraska commits to perform the following PM<sub>10</sub> monitoring and SIP development activities for these Group II areas:
