

40 C.F.R. § 49.101

Introduction.

- (a) What is the purpose of §§ 49.101 through 49.105? Sections 49.101 through 49.105 adopt legally and practicably enforceable requirements to control and reduce emissions of volatile organic compounds, nitrogen oxides, sulfur dioxide, particulate matter (PM, PM_{10} , $PM_{2.5}$), hydrogen sulfide, carbon monoxide and various sulfur compounds from new and modified true minor sources in the oil and natural gas production and natural gas processing segments of the oil and natural gas sector.
- (b) Am I subject to §§ 49.101 through 49.105? You are subject to the requirements if you:
- (1) Own or operate a new true minor oil and natural gas source or an existing true minor oil and natural gas source undergoing modification as determined pursuant to \S 49.153(a) that meets the criteria specified in paragraphs (b)(1)(i) through (v) of this section. Then you shall comply with the requirements of $\S\S$ 49.104 and 49.105, unless you obtain a source–specific permit as specified in paragraph (b)(2) or (3) of this section.
