

## 40 C.F.R. § 503.27

## Recordkeeping.

- (a) When sewage sludge (other than domestic septage) is placed on an active sewage sludge unit:
- (1) The person who prepares the sewage sludge shall develop the following information and shall retain the information for five years.
- (i) The concentration of each pollutant listed in Table 1 of § 503.23 in the sewage sludge when the pollutant concentrations in Table 1 of § 503.23 are met.
- (ii) The following certification statement:

I certify, under penalty of law, that the information that will be used to determine compliance with the pathogen requirements in (insert  $\S$  503.32(a),  $\S$  503.32(b)(2),  $\S$  503.32(b)(3), or  $\S$  503.32(b)(4) when one of those requirements is met) and the vector attraction reduction requirement in (insert one of the vector attraction reduction requirements in  $\S$  503.33 (b)(1) through (b)(8) if one of those requirements is met) was prepared under my direction and supervision in accordance with the system designed to ensure that qualified personnel properly gather and evaluate this information. I am aware that there are significant penalties for false certification including the possibility of fine and imprisonment.
