

## 40 C.F.R. § 63.4110

## What notifications must I submit?

- (a) You must submit the notifications in §§ 63.7(b) and (c), 63.8(f)(4), and 63.9(b) through (e) and (h) that apply to you by the dates specified in those sections, except as provided in paragraphs (a)(1) and (2) of this section.
- (1) You must submit the Initial Notification required by § 63.9(b) for an existing affected source no later than July 23, 2003, or no later than 120 days after the source becomes subject to this subpart. For a new or reconstructed affected source, you must submit the Initial Notification no later than 120 days after initial startup, November 20, 2002, or no later than 120 days after the source becomes subject to this subpart, whichever is later.
- (2) You must submit the Notification of Compliance Status required by  $\S$  63.9(h) no later than 30 calendar days following the end of the initial compliance period described in  $\S$  63.4140,  $\S$  63.4150, or  $\S$  63.4160 that applies to your affected source.
- (b) The Notification of Compliance Status must contain the information specified in paragraphs (b)(1) through (10) of this section and the applicable information specified in § 63.9(h).
- (1) Company name and address.
- (2) Statement by a responsible official with that official's name, title, and signature certifying the truth, accuracy, and completeness of the content of the report.
- (3) Date of the report and beginning and ending dates of the reporting period. The reporting period is the initial compliance period described in  $\S$  63.4140,  $\S$  63.4150, or  $\S$  63.4160 that applies to your affected source.

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
