

## 29 C.F.R. § 38.54

## Governor's obligations to develop and implement a Nondiscrimination Plan.

(a)

- (1) Each Governor must establish and implement a Nondiscrimination Plan for State Programs as defined in § 38.4(kkk). In those States in which one agency contains both SWA or unemployment insurance and WIOA Title I-financially assisted programs, the Governor must develop a combined Nondiscrimination Plan.
- (2) Each Nondiscrimination Plan must be designed to give a reasonable guarantee that all recipients will comply, and are complying, with the nondiscrimination and equal opportunity provisions of WIOA and this part.
- (b) The Nondiscrimination Plan must be:
- (1) In writing, addressing each requirement of paragraph (c) of this section with narrative and documentation;
- (2) Reviewed and updated as required in § 38.55; and
- (3) Signed by the Governor.
- (c) At a minimum, each Nondiscrimination Plan must:
- (1) Describe how the State Programs and recipients have satisfied the requirements of the following regulations:
