Charges imposed by an immediate relative or member of the beneficiary's household.

- (a) *Basic rule.* Medicare does not pay for services usually covered under Medicare if the charges for those services are imposed by—
- (1) An immediate relative of the beneficiary; or
- (2) A member of the beneficiary's household.
- (b) Definitions. As used in this section—

Immediate relative means any of the following:

- (1) Husband or wife.
- (2) Natural or adoptive parent, child, or sibling.
- (3) Stepparent, stepchild, stepbrother, or stepsister.
- (4) Father-in-law, mother-in-law, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, brother-in-law, or sister-in-law.
