

Compliance Today – March 2020 CMS on chiropractic services: Comply with Medicare billing requirements

In a recent [report](https://www.oig.hhs.gov/oas/reports/region9/91602042.asp), Medicare Needs Better Controls To Prevent Fraud, Waste, and Abuse Related to Chiropractic Services (<https://www.oig.hhs.gov/oas/reports/region9/91602042.asp>), the Office of Inspector General (OIG) determined that payments for chiropractic services did not comply with Medicare billing requirements. Overall, medical record documentation did not support medical necessity or corrective treatment.
