The European Commission <u>announced Feb. 12 that Cambodia no longer qualified for preferential trade status</u> under the "Everything But Arms" special arrangement. [1] The arrangement reduces tariffs and duties to zero for all products imported into the EU that are not arms. The arrangement requires that countries adhere to a list of standards and requirements enshrined in several United Nations and International Labour Organization conventions.
