

## Compliance Today – May 2022 Stumped for training ideas?

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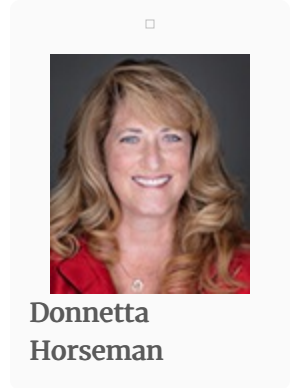

Check the United States Department of Justice news releases,<sup>[1]</sup> the Department of Health & Human Services Office of Inspector General enforcement actions page,<sup>[2]</sup> or the HIPAA News Releases page.<sup>[3]</sup> Try to find stories that are relevant to your organization and share them. Pull relevant information from the sources you use to stay current.



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
