After <u>Chinese medical supplies were criticized for low quality</u>, [1] including masks, tests and gloves sent to Europe, the Chinese government responded with new rules requiring additional checks before any medical equipment could be exported. The <u>new requirements caused confusion</u>, [2] first with the new certification process through the National Medical Products Administration, and then with additional checks announced on April 10.
