The European Commission released a plan on March 11, the Circular Economy Action Plan, [1] that builds on the Ecodesign Directive [2] that will help guide European Union-wide economic policy toward 2050. This is a big step for the commission, as cell phone manufacturers have resisted this policy for years.
