After a <u>report in *The New York Times*^[1] detailed how Clearview AI, an artificial intelligence start-up, scraped photos from the internet to create faceprints that could be used with powerful facial recognition technology, the American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU) <u>filed a lawsuit</u>^[2] in Illinois seeking a court order to forbid scraping photos without explicit consent.</u>
