On Sept. 30, California Governor Gavin Newsome <u>signed into law</u> a bill<sup>[1]</sup> that would ban 24 different harmful substances in cosmetics. The ban will be in effect starting Jan. 1, 2025. The bill, <u>AB 2762</u>,<sup>[2]</sup> bans more than trace amounts of certain harmful substances such as formaldehyde, mercury, diethylhexyl phthalate and methylene glycol.
