On August 28, China's Ministry of Commerce issued an update 11 to the technologies that require government approval before they can be exported or sold. The 23 technologies include space materials, 3D printing, encryption, large-scale high-speed wind tunnel design, and others. Notably, the restrictions also cover "technology based on data analysis for personalized information recommendation services," which analysts believe cover Bytedance's TikTok video-sharing app, which is at the center of a national security debate between the United States and China.
